The Supervised High Yield Fund ARSN 600 244 102 (**SHYF** or **Fund**) is an Australian Dollar hedged international Debt Securities managed investment scheme. The Manager's objective is to deliver capital preservation whilst generating a high return, low risk portfolio.

Investment Policy

The Fund is managed using an absolute return investment process. This process uses economic analysis and asset research combined with historic worst case stress testing to search out and discover the lowest risk best reward investment opportunities in the debt market. The Fund does not invest in junk bonds.

Unit Price and Performance Update

The Fund's net asset value (**NAV**) is calculated at the end of each month and represents the value of the Fund's assets less the value of the liabilities of the Fund (including the Fund's fees, costs and taxes). The value of a Fund unit is then calculated by dividing the Fund NAV by the number of units on issue in the Fund at the end of the relevant month.

Fund returns have been calculated using exit prices and reinvestment of distribution.

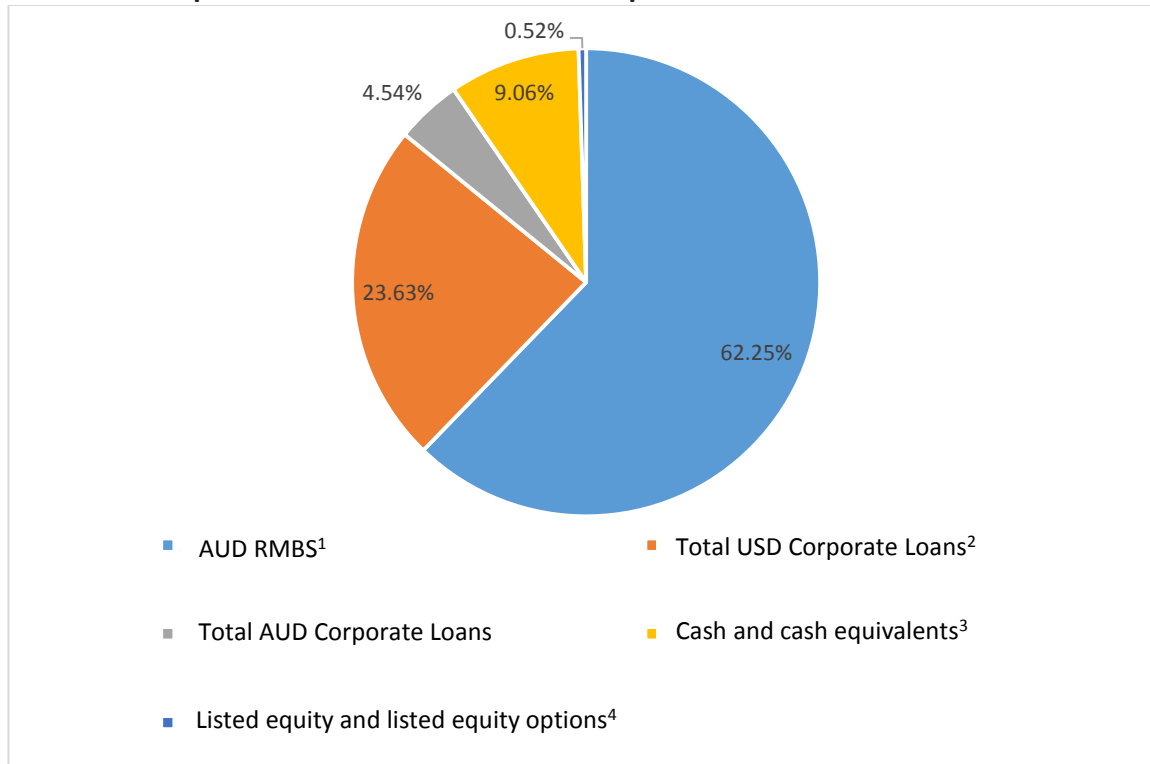

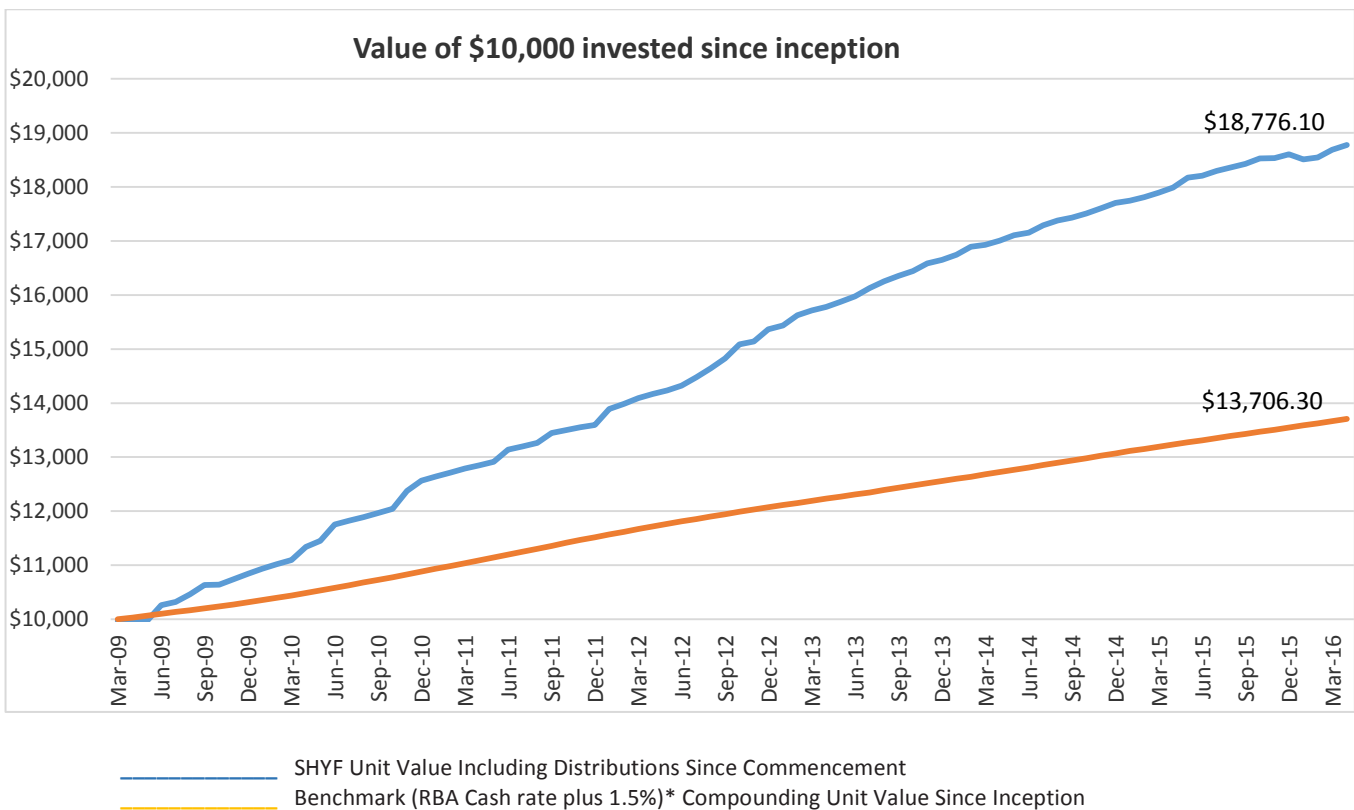

Manager's Comment

The Supervised High Yield Fund's unit price in April 2016 increased by 0.48% (net of fees). It was pleasing to see another positive performance in the low interest rate environment prevailing in financial markets around the globe.

Interest rates have remained at historically low levels during the month of April in 2016. In some countries such as Japan the government bond rate is negative. Investing in this new negative and low rate environment requires discipline and skill.

Even though Government Bond rates in the United States, Australia, Japan and in the Euro zone are at historically low levels opportunities for reasonable returns exist in both the Mortgage and Corporate mezzanine loans market.

In many ways we have a two tiered interest rate environment. Tier one being the historically low rates paid by the major world governments and tier two being the relatively high rates paid on mezzanine debt in the mortgage and corporate loans sector.

Although returns in the mortgage and corporate mezzanine loan sector look attractive, default risk can have the effect of reducing returns if loans are not repaid in full. It is now even more essential than ever before to review and stress test potential investments in the debt markets to ensure they are capable of surviving historical worst case default and recovery rates. Our stress testing methodology allows us to select investments that may offer reasonable returns and should be able to repay 100% of principal and interest obligations even if the default rates rise to the levels seen during the Global Financial Crisis.
